Pennsylvania Law Requires Clearances When Interacting With Or Treating Children

New provisions in Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Law require individuals to obtain several clearances every five years, in the course of their employment or volunteer activities, if they have either:

- Direct contact with children because they provide care, supervision, guidance or control of children, AND
- Routine interaction with children defined as "regular and repeated contact that is integral to a person's employment responsibilities."
- The following certifications are needed to comply with this law:
- Report of criminal history from PA State Police
- Child Abuse History Certification from PA Department of Human Services
- Federal criminal history from FBI

To help determine which members of your dental office staff need certifications, you may want to consult with your insurance carrier or attorney. However, PDA advises members to err on the side of caution and have all staff having any contact with children obtain the certifications.
