Complementary Continuing Education Course Offered

Dr. Dean Mersky will present "Evidence Based Comparative Approach to Better Crown and Bridge." The topics will include a research-based comparative overview of crown and bridge systems that will help the attendees gain a clearer understanding of materials, their uses, and limitations. Materials discussed will include traditional PFM's, Captek supported porcelain, allceramic, impressions, and adhesive systems. Each point of discussion will by accompanied by the supporting independent research. Attendees should expect to gain a deeper appreciation of why various materials work (and don't work) and in which situations they are best suited. Topics include:

- Differentiating the PFM sys-• tem: fit, biocompatibility, porcelain bond strength, esthetics
- All-ceramic strengths and weaknesses: system-wide comparatives
- Bottom-line comparisons for impression materials: what the research says, what the labs say
- Adhesion: a research-based

Support Water Fluoridation in Pennsylvania

Pennsylvania House Bill 1588, the Fluoridation Act, has been introduced into the legislature. If passed, this bill would require the fluoride content of water served by public water suppliers to domestic water connections of 500 or more to have content levels set between 0.8 milligrams per liter and 1.2 milligrams per liter. This is a range specified by the Department of Environmental Protection in consultation with the United States Public Health and the Environmental Protection Agency.

This range of fluoride effectively reduces tooth decay while minimizing the occurrence of dental fluorosis. For young children, water fluoridation is the only means of decay prevention that does not require a dental visit or motivation of parents and caregivers. As tooth decay is a serious problem that water fluoridation may have a positive impact on, please contact your representative and ask his or her support for HB 1588!
