Economic Census Forms Coming To 52,000 Dental Offices

Some 52,000 dental offices among more than 4 million American businesses will receive forms in December for a five-year economic census described by Federal Reserve chair Ben Bernanke as "indispensable to understanding America's economy." The population census is conducted every 10 years.

The economic census is important to understanding the dental economy and serves as the primary benchmark for the nation's gross domestic product estimates and other indicators of economic change, census officials said.

Because the census uses "payroll based criteria," most small dental offices will not receive forms although some will be sampled, said Paul Zeisset, special assistant in the economic census office.

These dentists operate private or group practices in their own offices (e.g. centers, clinics) or in the facilities of others such as hospitals or HMO medical centers, says the Census Bureau "offices of dentists" definition. The dental offices can provide either comprehensive preventive, cosmetic or emergency care or specialize in a single field of dentistry.

Response to the 2007 census is required of businesses, including dental offices, that receive the forms.

Completed forms are due February 12, 2008.
