Dr. Gronsky Recognized

The SDDS would like to recognize Dr. Joseph Gronsky for his on-going commitment and dedication to heading and organizing our involvement in the Free Non-Sectarian Dental Clinic, part of Jewish Family Services.

Dr. Gronsky has been leading this worthwhile cause for the past nine years. According to Sheila Nudelman Abdo, Executive Director of Jewish Family Services, the SDDS contributed over \$58,993 worth of dental care for eligible Lackawanna County residents who are uninsured from July 2006 to June 2007. Reporting for the fiscal year 2007/2008, shows that the number is already at \$43,188. This number is low in reality, considering all procedures completed are not submitted by dentists.

Ms. Nudelman Abdo shared that eligibility for the program is determined through an agency application and screening process. Eligible patients must be residents of Lackawanna County for a minimum of six months and not privately insured or publicly insured through County assistance.

No doubt, countless people have been served by this program that began in 1920.
