## Affordable Care Act

In late 2012, Governor Corbett announced that Pennsylvania would not pursue a state-based health insurance exchange. The administration is considering Medicaid expansion, but Governor Corbett maintained that implementation of an exchange under the Affordable Care Act (ACA) will be operated at the federal level. According to the administration, Medicaid expansion would cost Pennsylvania \$367 million in 2013-2014, with the state's share rising to \$1.2 billion in 2020-2021. Pennsylvania joined 28 other states in this decision. By law, governors can re-evaluate their decision to establish a state-based exchange on a yearly basis.


Since its passage in Congress in 2010, many questions remain about how the

ACA will impact health insurance, health care providers and patients. The expansion of medical insurance coverage and changes to how health care is financed could have a transformative impact on dentistry in Pennsylvania and across the country. Aspects of the ACA impact dentists not only as health care professionals, but also as small business owners and consumers of medical care. The full impact of the ACA on dentistry remains uncertain at this stage, but PDA can highlight some of the potential changes that will most likely occur in the near future. 
